TO THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, April is the Month of the Military Child, a time for Kansans to applaud the strength, sacrifice, heroism, and continued resilience that children of our service men and women make to our nation; and

WHEREAS, the acknowledgement will allow Kansans to recognize that when parents serve in the military, their children also serve; and

WHEREAS, more than 25,000 of Kansas' children have at least one parent serving in the military; and

WHEREAS, creating the opportunity to celebrate, as a grateful state, the responsibility to stand by our military children just as they and their families stand by us; and

WHEREAS, a month-long salute to military children will honor their contributions to Kansas, it will also celebrate that, just as their parents are today's strength to our nation, military children are the strength of our future.
